1.	Seasons	There are four seasons each year, autumn, winter, spring and summer.
2.	Autumn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Begins to get colder. ➤ Leaves start to fall from the trees. ➤ Daylight becomes shorter.
3.	Winter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Much colder. ➤ Sometimes it freezes, leaving frost and ice on the ground. ➤ Trees have bare branches. ➤ Night times are the longest.
4.	Spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Begins to get warmer again. ➤ Leaves begin to grow and trees may blossom. ➤ Daylight start to get longer.
5.	Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Becomes hotter. ➤ Days in summer have the most daylight. ➤ Trees are full of leaves. ➤ Lots of flowers, bees and butterflies.
6.	Weather	This includes the temperature outside. It describes the wind, rain, cloud, snow and sun.
7.	Daylight	Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of daylight changes with each season.
