Bronze Award: Hallam has been awarded the Food for Life Bronze award for its healthy and climate-friendly food culture! The school is working with Food for Life to transform the school's food culture and that of its local community, by connecting the children with climate-friendly and healthy food. As part of the Bronze award scheme, Hallam serves seasonal school meals, 75% of which are freshly prepared by an experienced school cook. The school also gives every pupil the opportunity to visit a farm and to cook and participate in food growing activities during his or her time at school.
