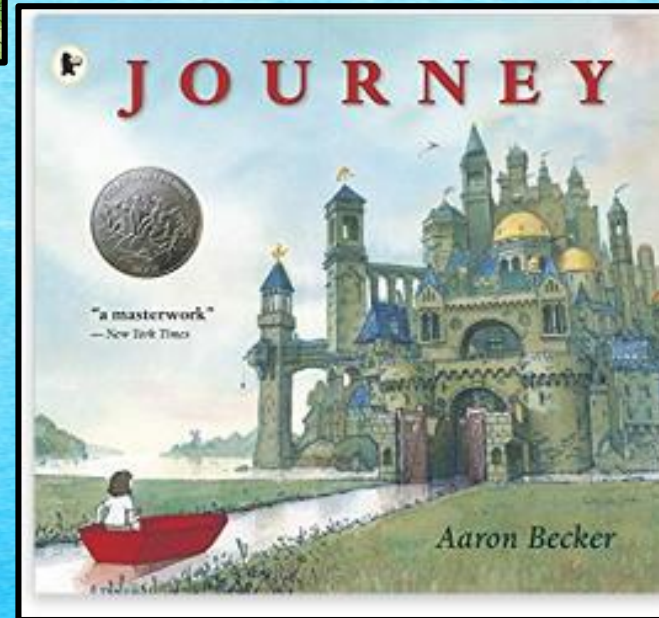
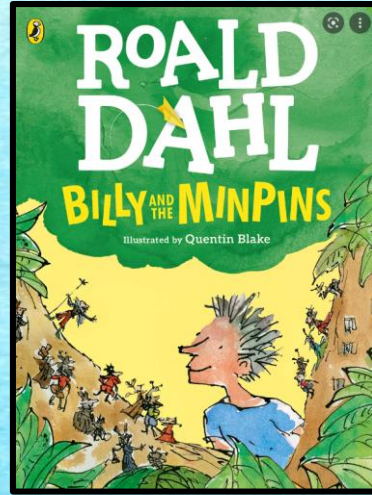
- ❑ We will continue to teach through high-quality books and texts.

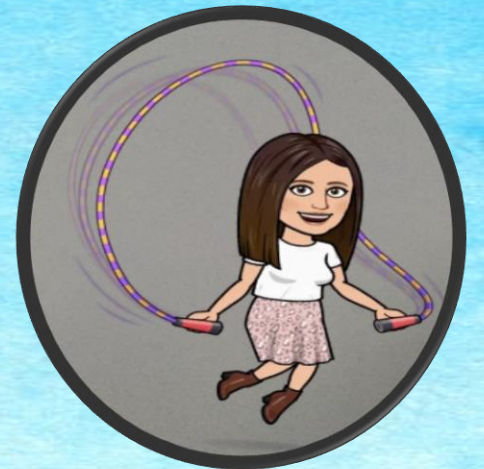


PE
