MATHS

- **Multiplication and Division:** Multiplying a 2/3-digit by a 1-digit number.
- Length & Perimeter: Perimeter of polygons and rectilinear shapes.
- **Fractions:** Equivalent Fractions and adding/subtracting fractions
- **Decimals:** Tenths and Hundredths as decimals

ENGLISH
