MATHS

Spring Units:

- Shape
- Addition and subtraction within 20
- Place value within 50
- Length and height
- Mass and volume

ENGLISH

Key texts – Rumble in the Jungle, The Emperors Egg, Giraffes Can't Dance, Funny Bones, Funny Bones and the Pet Shop, Little Red Riding Hood – a Scrapbook Diary

Text types – riddles, fact file, story diary

SCIENCE

Animals, including humans – understand the difference between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, identify and classify animals, describe animal bodies, describe the five senses

Seasonal changes – Spring

Key Vocabulary – human, animal, reptile, mammal, amphibian, bird, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, senses, sight, sound, smell, touch, taste

HISTORY

Monarchs – understand and know the purpose of a monarch and their role within our country, know some significant historical monarchs and place the monarchs in chronological order.

Key Vocabulary – monarchs, king, queen, chronological order, significant, Elizabethan, Victorian

GEOGRAPHY

The United Kingdom - locate 4 countries of the UK, know the different seas and oceans that surround the UK, know what a compass is and follow directional language.

Key Vocabulary – locate, United Kingdom, England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, capital city, sea, compass points

PE

We will cover the following units:

- Gymnastics
- Hit, catch, run
- Attack, defend and shoot
- Send and return

Key Vocabulary – balance, control, sequence, batter, bowl, catch, field, strike, throw, under-arm, over-arm

COMPUTING

We will cover the following units:

- Programming a moving robot
- Data and information: grouping

Key Vocabulary – instructions, sequence, algorithm, commands, predict, program, route, mat, debugging, object, group, sort, label, search

MUSIC

We will cover the following units:

- Rhythm
- Pitch

Key Vocabulary – beat, rhythm, pattern, high, low, long, short, notes

SMSC/RE/RHE

RE – children will learn how Jewish people celebrate special time, and link what we think is good about reflecting, thanking and praising

PSHE – children will know the importance of staying healthy, clean and making healthy, informed choices
